Drop-off-Carpool Line at the cafeteria/gym area (No earlier than 7:30 AM)

PRE-K/K parents may walk students into the cafeteria, to get them settled in, and leave immediately afterwards. At no time that parents may enter the classrooms until Back to School Night/PTO Meeting later in September. Please keep in mind that the longer parents stay with little ones, the more difficult it is to separate from them so that they may begin their day.

Pick-up-Carpool Line at the front-circular drive (By the main office-No later than 3:45 PM)

Afterschool Care-3:30-6:00 PM (Available for \$125/month and \$25/month for each additional child) Please sign up if this is a service that you require.

Athletics: Students in grades 3-8 may participate in any available sport in which they choose. There are three main requirements: 1) Each student must have an updated sports physical on file, 2) Each student must maintain grades of a C or better and have satisfactory conduct, 3) Pay the Participation fee of \$50 per sport.

Ancillary Classes-Each student takes Computer/Library, Art, Music, and PE (weekly)

Parent-Teacher Organization (PTO)-The PTO is an organization that supports the school in hosting many of the events held on our campus. The success of the PTO and our school, depends on each family taking an active part to contribute their time and talents to support our students.

The PTO also helps to welcome new families plan family social events, and run the Fall Festival, and field day each year. PTO meetings are usually held every month on the third Thursday, throughout the school year. An iris alert reminder will usually be sent to notify/remind all families.

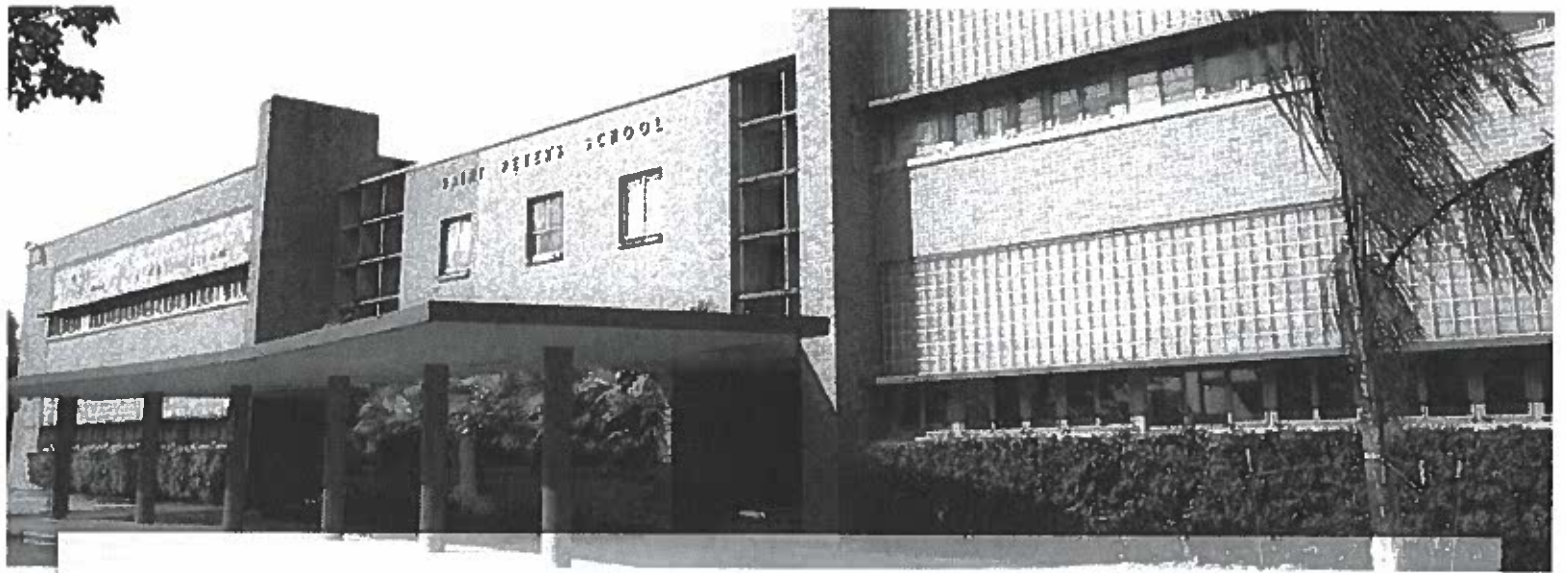

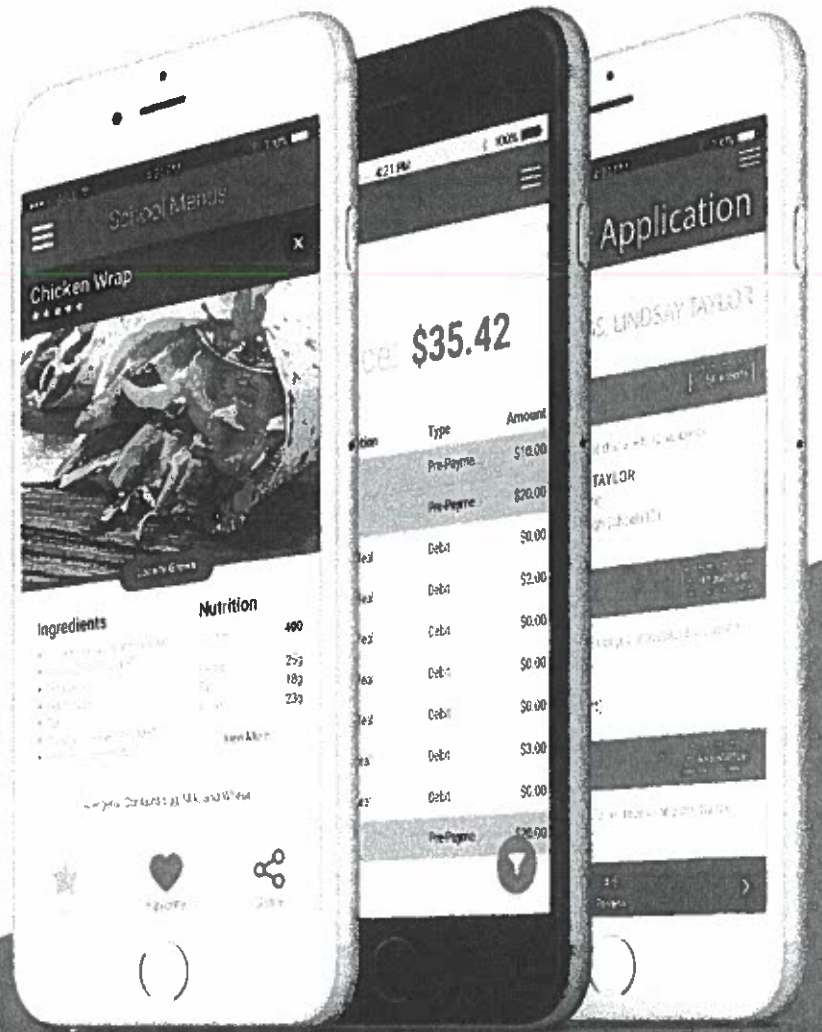
